Albert L. Crayton Memorial Scholarship	This scholarship is being created in the memory of Albert L. Crayton, a Vietnam war veteran who suffered from PTSD as a result of his service in the United States Air Force. Albert felt those who were afflicted with trauma from their service time were unable to access necessary supports needed to handle the transition from military life back into the community. He also felt that it was even more difficult to receive help if these supports were needed later in life rather than right after discharge. This scholarship will go to an individual who desires a pursuit of change in the mental health community for those who have served their country, along with many others who suffer from mental health issues daily.
Angel Flores Memorial Scholarship	Angel Flores was just beginning high school when he was struck by a car. He loved life, his family and school. He wanted to make his parents proud and set a good example for his sisters.
AVID Scholarship	This scholarship is awarded to a graduating AVID senior who has been in the AVID system at least three years. The student must have a record of leadership in AVID or in another school organization, and plan to attend a 4-year college or university.
B.I.G.D.O.G.S Organization Scholarship in Memory of Dalton Debrick	This scholarship was established in 2015 in memory of Dalton Debrick by The B.I.G. D.O.G.S. Youth Organization and his family. Dalton was a 2014 graduate of Nimitz High School who was active in youth sports in the Irving community for over 13 years, including the B.I.G. D.O.G.S. Organization. This scholarship is awarded to a male graduating Nimitz senior. The student must have been involved in at least four consecutive years in City of Irving and/or YMCA Sports. The student must demonstrate academic success by holding a minimum GPA of 3.0 and have given back to the Irving community.
Banking on America Scholarship	This scholarship was established in 1994 by Bank of America and is awarded to a graduating senior who plans to pursue a business-related course of study at a college or university.
Barbara Cardwell Future of Education Scholarship	Over forty-five plus years, Barbara Cardwell served the Irving ISD school district, faculty, staff, and students in a myriad of ways culminating in her twenty-one years of service as an Irving ISD Board of Trustee, with the highest quality of education services for the students of Irving ISD as her driving force. Mrs. Cardwell knew that securing top-notch educators was necessary to achieve excellence. Judy Hammond Memorial Athletic Scholarship	This scholarship is awarded to graduating seniors from any Irving ISD high school who have participated in junior/ senior athletic programs. A varsity letter is not required. Participation in college athletic programs is not required.
Kay Branch "Old Squirt" Scholarship	This scholarship was set to honor Kay Branch and her 50 years of service in the Irving ISD.
Keyes to Success Scholarship	The Keyes to Success Scholarship has been established by the faculty and staff of Keyes Elementary School and is awarded to a graduating senior who attended Keyes for more than two years, who has maintained a GPA of 2.5 or greater, and who plans to pursue a degree in education.
Kline Family Scholarship	Established by Suzanne Kline, a Irving ISD educator, and her family, this scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior who attended John Haley for at least three years, has a GPA of at least 3.0 and has community and athletic involvement.
