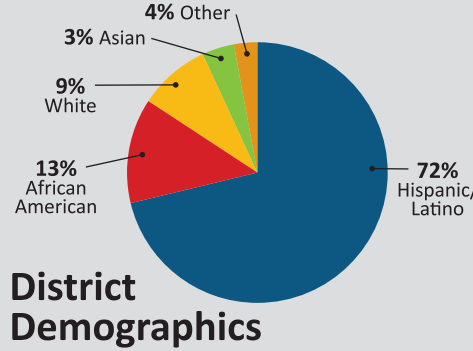

At the store without a cash register, Irving ISD staff can shop for school and office supplies, uniforms, backpacks, and more throughout the school year at no cost!



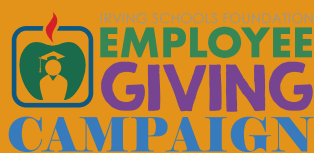
The first-ever ISF benefit concert featured performances by Prophets and Outlaws and the Grammy-nominated Eli Young Band.

Teachers and staff in Irving ISD can seek professional development grants up to \$1,000 for tuition and registration fees for seminars, workshops and conferences not funded by the District.



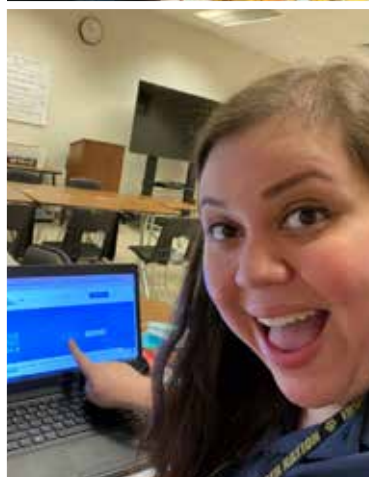
**Raised over \$297,950 by 2,500+ IISD employees**
