

This signature fundraising event allows ISF to continue its work in promoting educational equity and academic excellence throughout Irving ISD.



SPARKTANK

49 grants totaling \$223,956 10,608 students impacted

This grant program was created in 2013 and was based on the hit show "Shark Tank".

Teachers, staff, and students in Irving ISD are awarded grants to fund innovative projects across the district.

In 2023, we celebrated the accomplishment of Irving ISD seniors with scholarship awards ranging from \$1,000 to \$30,000

In 2023 Irving ISD students showed a need for school uniforms. ISF has since implemented Threads of Hope, a uniform store, where counselors can acquire free uniforms for students in need. ISF uses monetary donations to purchase uniforms and other clothing items in bulk.

Accessible Instructional Materials

Not all toys are accessible to all children, and Switched-On Learning wants to fix that! By adapting internal switches for electronic toys to a larger external switch, simple toys can become learning tools that can be manipulated by any of our students with speech-language, cognitive, or physical disabilities.
